NEW BUSINESS

- A. **Board Policy First Reading -** The Board of Education will review a new policy, 5330.02 Opioid Antagonists and will determine whether or not to update Policy 6210.01- Budget Fund Balance.
- B. **Benchmark Assessment (NWEA) Mid-Year Reporting Requirements -** Public Act 48, Section 104a requires districts to implement a benchmark assessment system for the 2022-23 school year for the purpose of measuring student proficiency in reading and mathematics. Districts must present the results from the benchmark assessments administered under section 104a to local boards. This is our required mid-year report to the Board.
- C. **Schools of Choice Resolution 2023-24** Information on annual Schools of Choice will be shared, followed by a recommendation to participate in the Kent County Schools of Choice program again for the 2023-24 school year.
