Section 6(6) Categories for Which Resident District Release is Not Required – Description & Guidelines

KISD Choice Program: • Advertised application/enrollment period throughout school year • Continued attendance until graduation or exit from district.

Section 105c Schools of Choices – Districts Within Contiguous Intermediate School Districts: • Open slots (limited or unlimited) advertised • Applications accepted only during advertised periods • Deadline for enrollment once notified of acceptance • District may deny enrollment to suspended or expelled applicants • Enrolling district and resident district must execute agreement regarding costs for Special Education students • Special Education students without agreement may not be enrolled • Continued attendance may be confirmed annually but must be allowed until student graduates, chooses to leave, or is expelled • Annual reapplication not required • District not required to provide transportation.

Part-Time Pupils:

Part-Time Pupil with FTE at .50 or Less: • If FTE exceeds .50 then a Resident District Release Application must be completed and submitted to Resident District

Part-Time Inter-District Split Schedule: • Student enrolled in both resident and non-resident district • Not under cooperative agreement • Membership FTE claimed at both districts • If FTE exceeds .50 then a Resident District Release Application must be completed and submitted to Resident District

Part-Time Non-Public Students Provided Non-Essential Electives at Public School Site: • If FTE exceeds .50 then a Resident District Release Application must be completed and submitted to Resident District

Part-Time Home-School Students Provided Non-Essential Electives at Public School Site: • If FTE exceeds .50 then a Resident District Release Application must be completed and submitted to Resident District

Cooperative Education Programs: • Programs operated under written agreement between districts • Provides specific type of educational programs • for students in certain districts • Cooperative agreement is approval to count the non-resident student in membership • Agreement may address transportation issues. *Examples of Cooperative Education Programs:* • Special Education Center Programs • Alternative Education Programs • Career & Technical Education/Vocational Programs • Non-Public & Home School Education for Non-Essential Electives Provided at Non-Public Site • Non K-12 Districts • non-public shared time programs at the non-public site.

Child of District Employee: • Employee's children may be enrolled without release from resident district • District not required to enroll • Board policy should exist • Tuition may not be charged • Reported as non-resident • District not required to provide transportation.

Alternative Education Pupil: • Pupil enrolled in alternative education program that meets one or more of the following: • suspended/expelled • previous drop-out • pregnant or a parent • referred by a court • enrolled under Sec 25 in disciplinary program.

Pupil Moved Out of District: • district of residence changes after fall count day • but prior to supplemental count day • continues to be enrolled on supplemental count day as a nonresident (reported as non-resident).

Pupil Expelled from Other District: • Pupil previously expelled • reinstated/enrolled by another district when expelling district denies reinstatement.

Pupil Enrolled in Middle College: • Pupil enrolls in middle college in a district within the same ISD as the pupil's resident district.

Pupil –Official Complain of Assault: • Pupil is a victim of criminal sexual assault or serious assault at resident district • official written complain made to law enforcement and school officials.

Other Section 6(6): • Pupils educated by ISD • Pupils educated at Michigan School for the Deaf and Blind • Pupils in Olympic Training
