



Secondary Trivia Game

Play the Waste Warrior Game with students in grades 5-12 as part of a Discovery Kitchen demonstration, in a classroom for an interactive nutrition education lesson, or with all ages at health fairs, community events and trade shows.

Waste Warrior is a simple, easy game where participants spin the game wheel or draw a trivia question card to answer questions about food waste reduction, recycling, the environment and related nutrition facts and information. Correct answers win an on-the-spot giveaway or a raffle ticket for a larger prize.

Materials:

- [Game wheel](#) with printed insert templates
OR container for trivia cards
- Trivia cards
- Waste Warrior Game POS
- Assorted prizes, your choice
- Raffle tickets (optional)



Method/How To Play:

- Participants spin the game wheel and answer a question from a same-color card as the wheel color section when the wheel stops spinning.
- If you do not have a game wheel – have the student draw a trivia question card from a container
- Correct answers receive a prize or giveaway. (Option – allow students to answer another question to receive a nicer prize)

Tips for Success:

- Gain advance permission from the principal and/or teacher to conduct the game.
- If your game is part of a Discovery Kitchen event, set up at a separate table away from the food/recipe demonstration
- For younger grades, request one grade or table at a time are released to visit the table and play the game to minimize disruption
- Prize Strategy – plan according to your budget and logistics
- Contestants answer a question correctly and receive (your choice):
 - Small giveaway, sticker, or allow students to select from a ‘treasure chest’ of assorted prizes (can be leftovers from other promotions or holiday celebrations, lucky tray, etc.)
 - Healthy snack, homemade or purchased
 - Raffle ticket for larger prize(s). Be sure to announce the big winner(s) soon through signage, school announcements or district social media.
