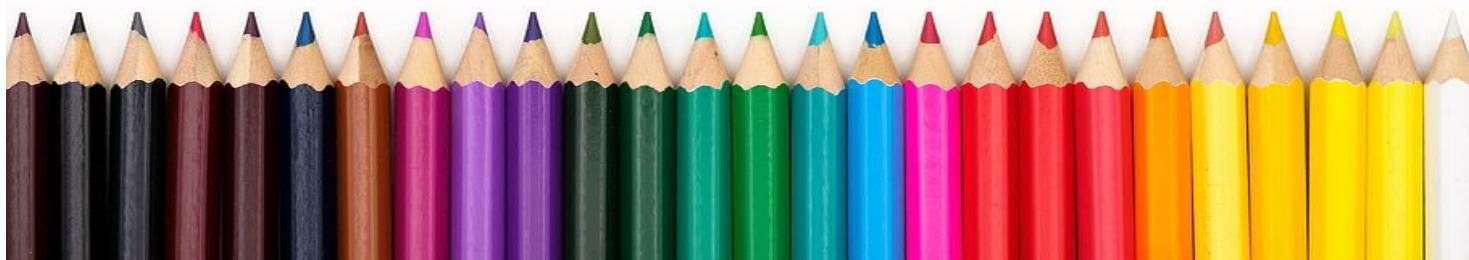
Hello Families!

- ☐ 3 boxes of Crayola crayons 24-pack (no larger or smaller amounts)
- ☐ 2 boxes #2 HB Dixon Ticonderoga soft lead pencils
- ☐ 2 packages pencil cap erasers
- ☐ Pencil box
- ☐ 1 pair Fiskars scissors - 5" - pointed tip
- ☐ 2 boxes of Crayola Washable markers 8-pack, classic colors, wide tip
- ☐ 4 plain (no pictures) plastic pocket folders
- ☐ 12 Elmer's washable glue sticks large size only (.77 oz) (The small sticks dry out quickly and break off easily)
- ☐ 1 box Expo dry erase markers - Black or Colored
- ☐ 2 containers of Clorox disinfectant wipes
- ☐ 1 Roll of Paper Towel
- ☐ 1 box Ziploc bags (variety of sizes)
- ☐ Tissues
- ☐ Hand Sanitizer (8 oz)
